Summary: These guidelines assist health professionals in the clinical management of **methamphetamine** use disorder and related presentations. These guidelines also aim to improve understanding of methamphetamine use disorder in health services and the community.

Topics covered in the guidelines include the management of acute and complex presentations, including behavioural disturbances, polydrug use, injecting methamphetamine use, cognitive impairment and co-occurring mental health symptoms, as well as recommendations for reducing harm, working with specific populations, and supporting families and carers.
